- Art. 5—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00; this sum and the amount of Dog Tax money refunded by the County to be given to the Hinsdale Free Public Library.
- Art. 6—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for road work on the Sky View Grove development at Ashmere Lake.
- Art. 7—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for work on the Plunkett Lake Road.
- Art. 8—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to permit the Western Mass. Electric Co. to install new street lights on Main St. and a portion of Maple St.
- Art. 9—To see if the Town will vote to accept the list of Jurors presented by the Selectmen.
- Art. 10—To see if the Town will vote to give the Tax Collector the same powers Town Treasurers have by law when appointed Collector of Taxes.
- Art. 11—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Selectmen, to borrow money from time to time in anticipation of revenue or reimbursement of the financial year beginning January 1, 1953, and to issue a note or notes therefor payable within one year, and to renew any note or notes as may be given for a period of less than one year in accordance with Section 17, Chapter 44, General Laws.
- Art. 12—To see if the Town will vote to constitute the Board of Selectmen the Board of Public Welfare for the year 1954, and to authorize an annual salary of \$50 for each member for attendance at meetings and \$50 additional for the District Representative for attendance at District meetings.
- Art. 13—To see if the Town will vote to have the cash in the Treasury transferred to help defray the expenses of the ensuing year.
- Art. 14—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate \$300.00 for repairs to the town sand shed and storage building on Depot St.



- Art. 15—To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from the Overlay Reserve surplus fund the sum of \$1000.00 for a Reserve Fund.
- Art. 16—To see if the Town will raise and appropriate the sum of \$1000 00 for continuance of work on Tully Mt. Road so-called, under Chapter 90, General Laws of Massachusetts. Work to be started at northwesterly end of present completed work under Chapter 90 and continued toward the Dalton Town Line.
- Art. 17—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to purchase a road sander and appropriate a sum not to exceed \$275 from the Road Machinery Fund for purchasing it.
- Art. 18—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sums of \$98.22 for balance of 1952 Collector's expenses and \$66.55 for 1952 Tax Title expenses to be paid to Alfred G. Kirchner, Tax Collector.
- Art. 19—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250.00 for the purpose of providing suitable headquarters for the Harriet E. Bridge Post, V.F.W., in accordance with Chapter 40, Sect. 9, of the General Laws.
- Art. 20—To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$1300 for 1952 Tax Collector's salary.
- Art. 21—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the purchase of a tractor shovel at a cost of \$6,100. The tractor will be paid for by using \$2800 transferred from the Road Machinery Fund; The additional \$3300 will be subscribed by the issuing of a series of three Town of Hinsdale Notes, each of the notes will fall due, annually, for a period of three years, or \$1100 will be paid each year, over the three year period.
- Art. 22—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the purchase of a new truck for the use of the town at a cost of \$5000. The truck will be paid for by use of \$2800 transferred from the Road Machinery Fund; the additional \$2200 will be subscribed by the issuing of two Town of Hinsdale Notes, each of the notes will fall due, annually, for a period of two years, or \$1100 will be paid each year, over the two year period.
- Art. 23.—To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Selectmen to arrange for installation of a Street Light on the corner of New Windsor Road and Stonehouse Road and appropriate \$24.00 therefor.
- Art. 23—To do and transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.

## SELECTMEN'S REPORT

The arrangement of the 1952 Hinsdale Report is similar to the 1951 report. No innovations have been introduced this year, although a complete listing of all real estate assessments is included. This is in accordance with a motion voted and passed at the annual meeting last year.

Two special meetings were called during the year. The first, on March 24, was for the purpose of making additional appropriations for snow removal, town officers' salaries, and for making disposition of the small tractor which had become a liability and was considered to be uneconomical to repair. The second special meeting was held on November 14, and was called to appropriate additional funds for Old Age Assistance, and minor sums for several other accounts which were depleted by unusual circumstances.

It was necessary during the course of the year to make several appointments to fill vacancies in town offices. The death of Dr. Sylvester M. Lent, who had served for a number of years as Chairman of the Finance Board, was a sad occasion to his many friends in Hinsdale and elsewhere, and to those of us who had been associated with him in town affairs. Allyn W. Smith was appointed to fill the vacancy on the Finance Board. Mr. J. Cornelius Brown, Secretary of the Finance Board, moved from Hinsdale but no replacing appointment was made. The resignation of Mrs. Katherine A. Kirchner on Dec. 1 necessitated the appointment of a new treasurer, Mrs. Elaine R. Blake.

It will be noted that some of the proposed appropriations for operating expenses to be voted on under Article 4 at the annual meeting on Feb. 9, 1953 are increased slightly over last year's amounts. The Town has the same problems as a family in trying to adjust its living expenses to its income. If the various projects are to be carried out and the many functions of the town government performed, it is necessary that adequate funds be available for the purpose. Experience has indicated that the general inflationary trend in our country over the last few years is reflected in the town's "living expenses". If you will refer to previous issues of the Town Report you will see that there has been a steady rise in the cost of operations while the number of functions performed has remained relatively the same. Wherever men are hired or materials or services purchased, increased costs seem to be inevitable.

Chapter 39, Section 10, of the General Laws\* provides that "The selectmen shall insert in the warrant for the annual meeting all subjects the insertion of which shall be requested of them in writing by ten or more registered voters of the town . . .". Several articles appearing in the warrant this year have been submitted in this manner.

It should be kept in mind that with the present valuation of the town, each increase of \$1000 in appropriations, excepting those cases where funds have already accumulated, or where reimbursement will be received from the Commonwealth, represents an increase of about 50 cents in the tax rate.

## REPORT OF THE CEMETERY COMMITTEE

The committee in charge of operating the Hinsdale Cemetery, located on Maple Street, has for some time, been debating a new development program to further the facilities of the cemetery for future years. Much time and discussion has been centered on the woodland, now owned by the cemetery and located at the North end. It is feared that because of the rugged terrain in that area, the preparation costs would be prohibitive. Some discussion has also been focused on a strip of cleared land located on the Eastern boundry of the cemetery. This strip is not a part of the cemetery at present, but consideration has been given to attempt a negotiation for it. It is felt that the over all cost of this strip including development would probably be somewhat higher in total, but since we would end up with somewhere in the neighborhood of (4) times the number of plots available, our cost per plot would be appreciably lower. At present no decision has been made as to which of the above line of thinking will be further explored.

At the last regular meeting of the committee, a great deal of discussion was concentrated on the prices of plots in the cemetery. The final vote favored increasing prices on all plots. It was further voted, that to residents of the Town of Hinsdale, this price increase would not become effective until March 1st, 1953, thus any resident of the Town, interested in a plot in the cemetery who wish to receive benefit of the old prices should contact the Committee at once. It was further discussed and voted that all plots in the cemetery, having been sold, but not completely paid for, having been in poor standing over one year should revert back to the cemetery, that portion of the plot not already used.

It is the feeling of the Committee that by increasing these prices, and reorganizing the plots which are in arrears, they will be able to build up a fund for the future development and expansion of the cemetery.

It is the desire of the committee to keep the cemetery grounds in a high degree of repair and beautification at a minimum operating cost. This is being accomplished by the close cooperation of the "Town Committee" and the "Perpetual Care Committee", both of which work in unison to care for this Little City which continues to grow.

All this was brought to the attention of the Selectmen two years ago.

I should like to ask for an appropriation of fifty dollars to cover repairs. The Lt. Harriet E. Bridge Post, Veterans of Foreign Wars has offered the sum of \$35 to replace or secure the plaque if a person can be found to do the work. The sum of \$50 should cover the balance of repairs.

This year we were met with an infestation of gypsy moth much more severe than in many previous years. Fortunately this was confined mostly to the southeastern part of the town and by creosote spray to the egg clusters we believe we have this menace under control.

It is the duty of the moth superintendent to scout, send specimens of suspected trees known to have the disease and remove, or have removed infected trees. Money raised and appropriated for Dutch Elm Disease Control should be spent for this purpose only, and only by the moth superintendent.

## REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

To the School Committee and Citizens of Hinsdale:

Herewith is submitted my eighth annual report as Superintendent of your school.

With 46 pupils in the first grade, we felt something should be done to improve this unfavorable learning situation. Various suggestions were made at a meeting of the parents and the factors for and against each were discussed. It was finally decided to employ a second teacher and use the lunchroom part of the time as a classroom. Mrs. Herbert Prew assisted until a first grade teacher was obtained. The two teachers carried on for a while. Then Mrs. Collins left and Mrs. Prew returned to assist. This arrangement works out rather well and we shall continue as is for the rest of the year. However, we have been instructed by the department of public safety that we may not have more than 25 in each of the basement rooms next year and will be expected to move out of the basement after that. A planning committee is at work on this problem of housing. Whatever arrangements are made for housing these children next year will require at least one new teacher.

Provision for one additional teacher for part of the fiscal year is included in the 1953 budget.

You will also note that there is an increase in the transportation item necessitated by the present contract figures but which will be reimbursed by the state. There is an increase of about \$500 for all other items in the budget.

The estimated increase of net cost for 1953 is \$1,315.98.

I wish to point out that the 1953 budget is figured on things as they are now, with another room available. When the town decides the matter of housing, adjustments will have to be made.

### Personnel:

Dr. Guerrino Zanconato is the new school doctor.

Miss Rose Conley has retired after a long and valuable service and Mrs. Norman Sanderson succeeds her as school nurse.

Mrs. Virginia Collins, our first grade teacher, has resigned.

Mrs. Mary Hogan is the new first grade teacher.

Mrs. Herbert Prew is assisting in the first grade part of the time.

### School Entrance:

Children may enter the first grade if they are five years and six months of age on or before the 1st day of school of the current school year. Consequently children will be admitted to the first grade in September 1953 if born on or before March 9, 1948. Certificates of birth and vaccination are required at the time of entrance.
