## HOLIDAY RECYCLING REMINDER

Happy Holidays! Thank you for your recycling efforts over the past year. Following are some guidelines for recycling during the holiday months and all year long:

Please DO include the following items in your paper recycling mix:
$\checkmark$ corrugated cardboard boxes, paperboard gift boxes.
YES
$\checkmark$ paper shopping bags (any type of handle is okay)
$\checkmark$ paper greeting cards (not with metallic inks, glitter, or foil; remove batteries)
$\checkmark$ catalogs, calendars, and magazines
Please DO NOT include the following items in your household recycling:
$\boxtimes$ ribbons, bows, and tinsel (reusable from year to year) and Wrapping paper.


TIP: Keep a recycle bin or paper bag handy near gift unwrapping.

NO
$\boxtimes$ holiday light strings (recycle in scrap metal dumpsters at transfer stations and at scrap metal dealers)
$\boxtimes$ packing peanuts, Styrofoam ${ }^{\text {TM }}$, bubble wrap, inflatable "air pillow" packaging (clean, dry packing materials accepted for reuse at "pack $n^{\prime}$ ship" stores.)
$\boxtimes$ plastic bags, plastic shipping envelopes, bubble wrap, air pillows (recycle at grocery stores along with clean, dry plastic bags marked \#2 or \#4 https://nextrex.com/view/educate\#materials1)
$\boxtimes$ molded plastic packaging from items like toys and electronics.
