Dick opened meeting, asked for cell phones to be turned off, and if anyone else was recording this meeting. Viv made a motion to approve April 28, 2021 meeting minutes, Dick seconded, both said Aye. Ray was late coming to this meeting.

Bob said we have an article on the Annual Town Meeting Warrant to pay our consulting engineer \$29,500 for a comprehensive study of our Water System and produce a long-range maintenance and improvement plan. We have reserve funds to complete this. We don't have adequate funds in the reserves for the Sewer III study.

Based on Dave Prickett's recommendations, the FY22 Sewer Rate Structure needs to be increased. Viv made a motion to raise Sewer III EDU rate to \$600 (a \$150 increase) beginning July 1, Ray seconded. Bob explained we are not proposing to raise Sewer I. But the Town still needs to have reserve built up to maintain the system. He asks if there is a benefit to having an incremental increase? We know that Pittsfield is going to increase their rates, should we keep that in consideration for system maintenance? Dick said the number of Sewer III users is currently 416 and Sewer I users total 424. Discussion followed. All said Aye.

Viv feels very strongly about re-establishing a Water & Sewer committee to report to SB/TA and outlined its mission and parameters. The group would consider pumps, long range plans, rate structure, SB does not have time to do on its own.

- •Members will be appointed by SB preferably one person from Sewer I, Sewer III, and Finance
- •Meet as needed, at least 6 times a year
- •Make recommendations to Select Board/Town Administrator on all aspects of W&S system, keeping them up to date on problems
- •Assist in hiring, as needed (in an advisory capacity)
- •Consider reports and advisories from Dave Prickett and other consultants as needed
- •Consider long-range plans for system
- •Help W&S Superintendent solve situations as necessary by being available for advice, history and support
- •Notify SB/administration of problems as they arise.

Viv made a motion to put the committee back in place. Dick has reservations on how it will operate. It will not act as an independent agency. The Select Board and Water & Sewer Committee will have open lines of communications. A member of the Select Board is recommended as a member of this committee. Shaun suggested this committee report to Town Administrator. The \$45 million system needs good shepherding to make sure it runs smoothly. All said Aye.

Water and Sewer policies statements are printed on the back of invoices. Residents can sign and return the policy and submit with their payments. If they pay online, they can print, sign, scan and return electronically. We can assume if they are using the Water & Sewer System they will abide by the policies.

Viv made a motion to adjourn, Ray seconded all said Aye. Select Board meeting immediately followed.
